



Medical Volunteer Mobile Medical Unit

Medical volunteers serving on Mobile Medical Units will assist patients of Care Net of Puget Sound in the following service areas: Ultrasound Sonographer, Physician (Nurse Practitioner, Physician's Assistant) providing STI screenings on the Mobile Medical Units. Medical volunteers maintain professional standards of care and works in conjunction with clinic volunteers and staff to assure that patients are receiving the best medical, nursing, psychosocial and spiritual care possible.

Time Commitment: Dependent on position. 1 shift per week/every other week

Supervised by: Medical Director and Nurse Manager/MMU Staff Nurse

Qualifications:

1. Be a committed Christian who demonstrates a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.
2. Exhibit strong commitment and dedication to the biblical teachings of the sanctity of life, sanctity of marriage.
3. Agree with and be willing to uphold the Ministerial Statements and policies of the organization.
4. Exhibits spiritual maturity and the ability to carry the burdens of others.
5. Effective interpersonal communication skills, especially oral communications.
6. Effective listening skills
7. Good organizational skills
8. Trained RDMS or through Care Net provided training for Ultrasound Sonography.
9. Heart to serve with compassion putting the woman and her needs first.

Application and Training Requirements:

1. Volunteer application, testimony, and background check.
2. Care Net 101 Training to understand the history, mission and outreach of Care Net of Puget Sound
3. Evangelism training
4. Successful completion of the Mobile Unit's Orientation/On the Job Training

Job Requirements:

1. Insure that the patient feels welcome upon her arrival for medical care.
2. Assist with or performs medical services (depending on the position)
3. Reinforce the humanity of the unborn child with the patient.
4. Provide patient education.
5. Insures Universal Precautions and infection control guidelines are followed.
6. Complete necessary patient forms associated to the client visit with provider notes.
7. Order labs as needed. Prescribe medications (STI Testing)
8. Provides medical consults as needed
