



to the extent that we shock the liberals of the city.



"Church plants need new people, new ideas and new vision if they are going to emerge out of the darkness into the sunlight. Established churches tend to be more concerned about building upkeep, personality of preacher, who's on board, and the program schedule for the next year...church plants are completely stripped of all illusions. Do or die. Reach out or close the doors. Invite or implode. Plants are desperate for growth. Without growth, the church folds. This reality keeps church plants on their knees, crying out to God. - Joel Comiskey


